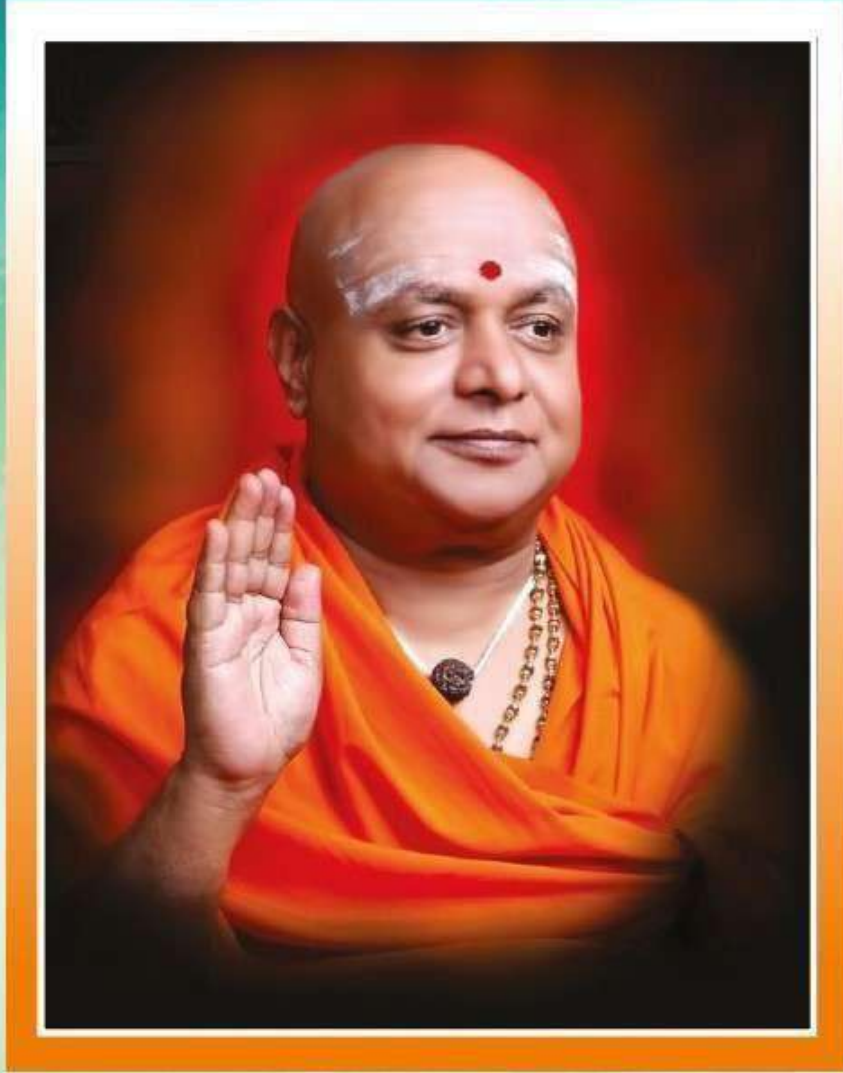

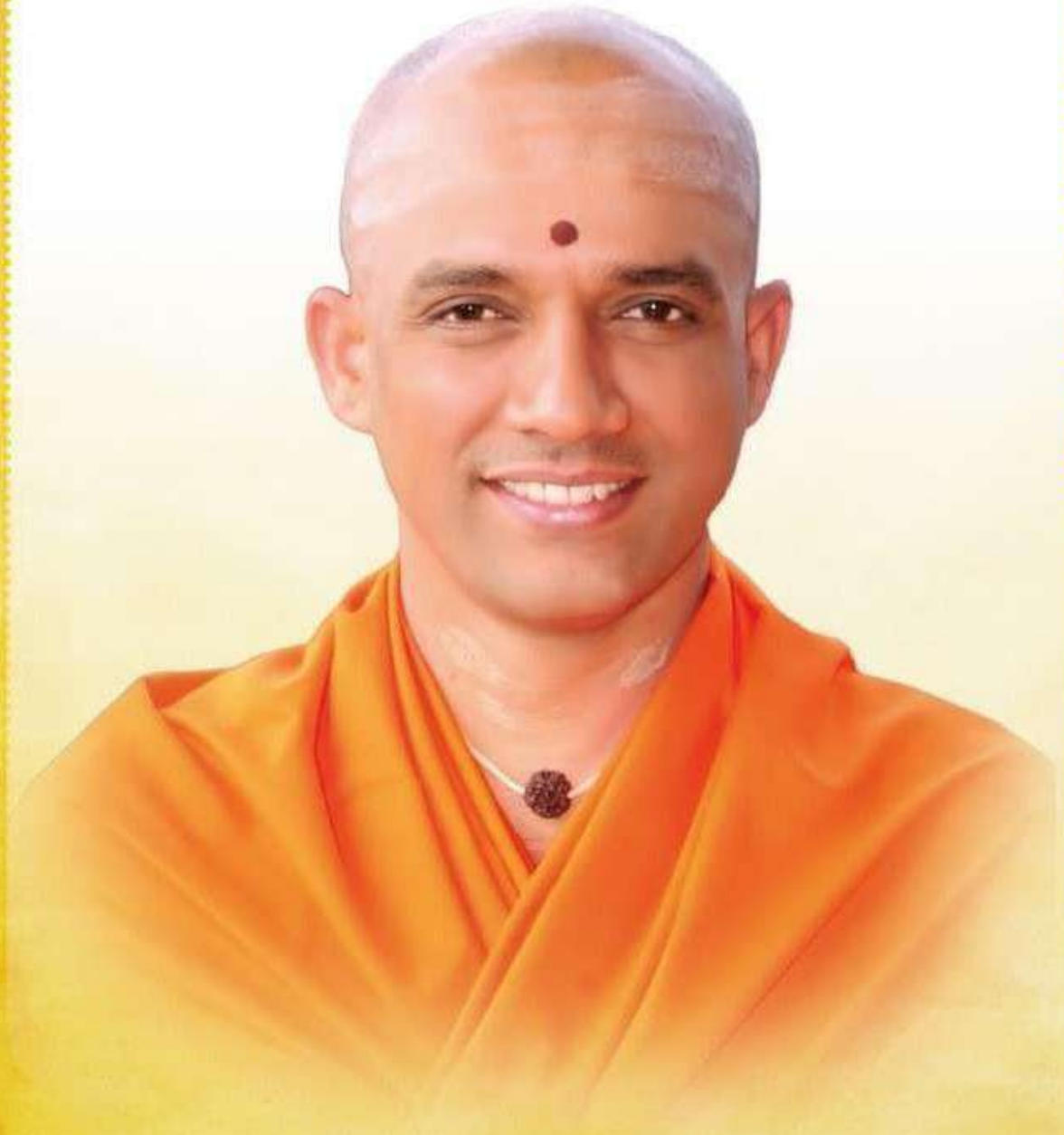

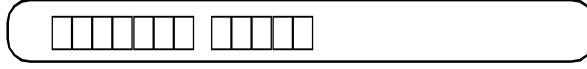

NOTE :

1. The fees for each semester must be paid in one instalment.
2. All students are expected to keep the cash receipts safe for all the fees paid.
3. A Student who has attended the class for the whole or part of a day in a semester is liable to pay the tuition fees, special fees, laboratory fees, etc for the whole semester.
4. If a student fails to pay the tuitionfee withinthe stipulated period a fine will be charged.
5. The special fee and deposits should be paid along with the fee for the term or the first instalment at the time of admission.
6. Students who are in arrears of tuition fee shall not be allowed to attend the university examination.
7. A fee of Rs.100 /- shall be paid by students who apply for the issue of their Transfer certificate.
8. Afee of Rs.200 /- will be charged for the issue of duplicate transfer certificate which shall not be issued unless it is proved to the satisfaction of the Principal that the original was lost beyond recovery.
9. College buses ply between the college and the other places for the convenience of staff and students. Bus fees shall be paid by the students every semester.
10. University examination fee shall be paid by the students| as prescribed by the university.

V. ADMISSIONS AND WITHDRAWALS

1. All candidates seeking admission must apply using the form supplied and submit their transfer Certificate and the statement of marks at the time of admission.
2. No candidate will be enrolled or allowed to attend classes if she fails to remit the tuition fee on or before the notified date.
3. A student who leaves the institution in the middle of a semester cannot claim refund of fee as a matter of right. She should apply for withdrawal in the prescribed form.
4. If any student is expelled from the college, intimation of the fact there of will be given by the Principal to the parent or guardian and the transfer certificate will be sent to the University.
5. A student who wants her Transfer and Conduct Certificates on leaving the college shall apply to the Principal in writing giving her full name as recorded in the college register, her parent or guardian's name, class and group or main subject of study, years of study, roll number in the class last attended, her address and such other details.
6. Application for TC& CC should be made sufficiently in advance of the date on which they may be required.
7. Transfer Certificate will not be given to students who have not cleared their fees and other dues.

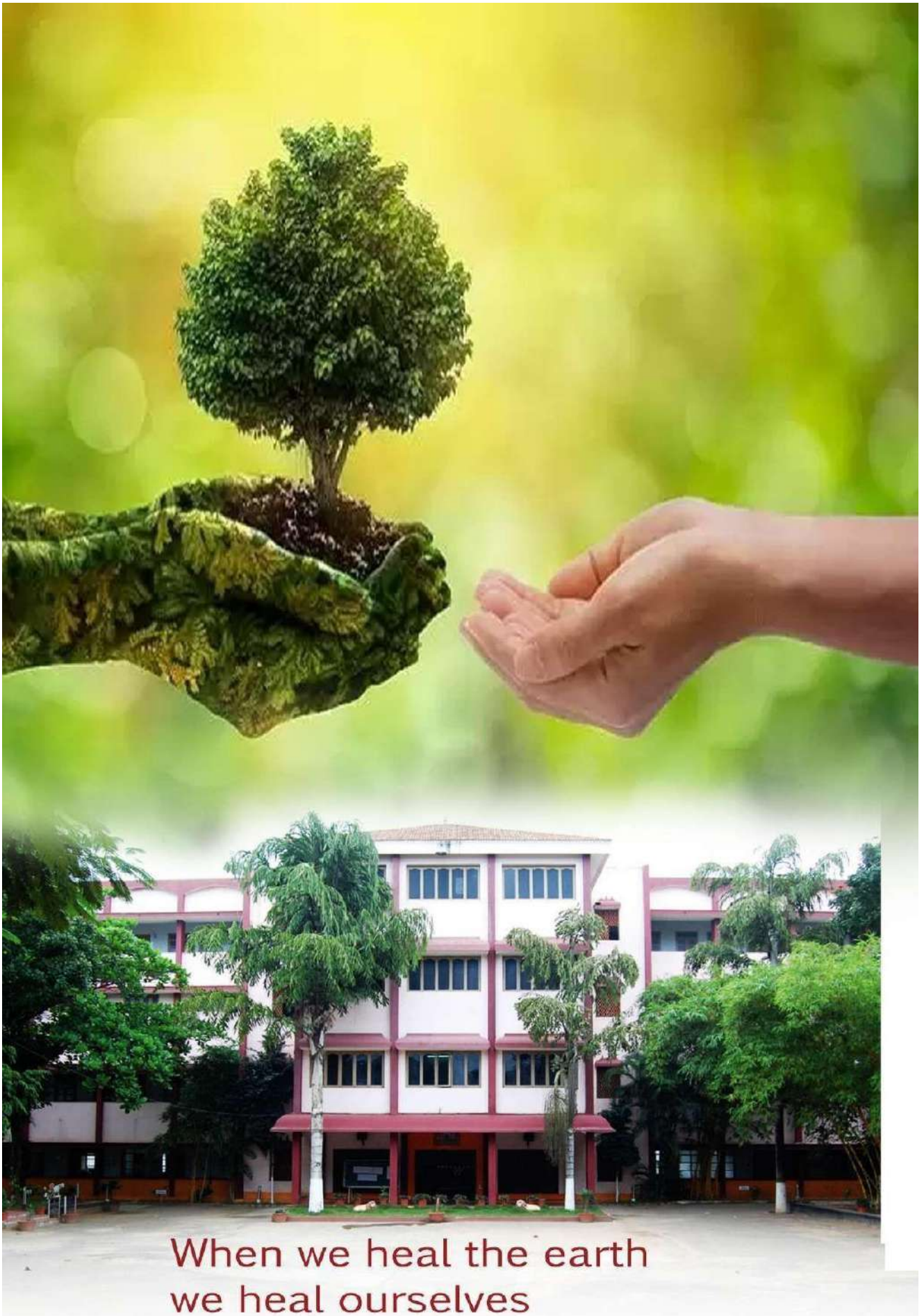
